The Trail of Terror will feature a hike through the woods with scenes of blood and gore. It will take place on Saturday from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Adults are \$5 with children under 10 costing \$3.

Haunted Hayride

With this year’s theme of “An Old Fashioned Haunting,” this year’s Haunted Hayride in Jaffrey will include a graveyard scene, a dungeon scene, witches, a mad scientist’s laboratory and a jungle.
